Annual Notification of College Admission Requirements

The UC and CSU education systems require the satisfaction of the following a-g courses:

“a”: History/Social Sciences: 2 years required **(Grove, 3 years req.)**

- One year of World History, cultures and geography and one year of U.S. History

“b”: English: 4 years required **(Grove, 4 years req.)**

- No more than one year of ESL-type course is acceptable

“c”: Mathematics: 3 years required, 4 years recommended **(Grove, 4 years req.)**

- 3 years of college-preparatory (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, fulfill minimum requirements)

“d”: Laboratory Science: 2 years required, 3 years recommended **(Grove, 3 years req.)**

- Two years of laboratory science in two of three foundational areas: biology, chemistry, physics

“e”: Foreign Language: 2 years required, 3 years recommended **(Grove, 3 years req.)**

“f”: Visual and Performing Arts: 1 year required **(Grove, 1 year req.)**

“g”: College Preparatory Elective: 1 year required **(Grove, 2.5-3 years req.)**

Additionally, the Grove requires 15-20 credits of internship (approx. 1.5-2 years), 1 semester of Health, 1 year of Economics/American Government, 2 years of P.E., the high school exit exam and a senior project.
