

## Welcome Seniors!

- Use College Board to research and organize your college search. Follow announcements on Grove Facebook page, weekly counseling announcements, google classroom and calendar, and bulletin board.
- Visit campuses; attend open houses and information sessions, schedule interviews.
- Open and read YOUR EMAILS! Keep up your grades!

### June

- Attend college essay writing workshop on Friday, June 8
- Submit “Letter of Recommendation request” by June 8
- Work on your Common App Profile and Awards and Activities list.
- Work on your essays.
- Do you plan on applying ED/EA?
- Does the college of your choice offer/require interviews?
- Submit Cal Grant Information release or opt-out form by June 7.
- Use your summer to get ahead with your applications and your senior project.

### August

- UC application opens, start completing it.
- Common App new application cycle opens.
- Take SAT/SAT Subject test.
- Continue to work on your essays.

### September

- Complete post-secondary plans survey
- Register for the SAT School Day if interested.
- September 7, UC application webinar
- 2-week SAT Prep class @ Grove, see flyer in the hallway.
- Gather and organize your extra-curricular activities.
- **Start completing UC, Common App application.**
- Narrow your college choices to approx. five soon.
- Check if your colleges/major is impacted.
- If students apply to an impacted major, they should **ALWAYS** declare an alternate major that is **NOT** impacted.
- Check for additional admission requirements, i.e. SAT Subject Tests, auditions, portfolios, interviews etc.
- Check Early Action, Early Decision deadlines.
- Work on your essays.
- Apply for scholarships.
- Check for open houses.

### October

- October College Fair at Redlands High School, October 10
- Starting October 1 you can submit your 2019-2020 FAFSA using the 2017 tax returns.

- FAFSA Parent workshop, October 4
- **October 1: Start CSU application:**
- **Take SAT, ACT and/or SAT Subject tests**
- Send scores through your College Board account to the colleges
  - UC: send scores to one campus – all campuses will receive your scores
  - CSU: send scores to CSU Mentor code 3594 or send scores to one campus – all campuses will receive your scores
- Check if your college requires you to complete the CSS (financial aid) Profile.
- October 12 – Crafton Senior Day

## November

- **UC Application filing period November 1-30.**
- **Submit UC and CSU applications by November 30.**
- **After you submitted, check your email, follow through with any requests made by colleges and activate your student account.**
- **Private colleges – deadlines are different from college to college**
- **Take SAT or SAT Subject tests**

## December

- **This is your last chance to take the SAT, ACT and/or SAT Subject Tests**
- Get ready for Redlands Scholarship Foundation Application, complete worksheet, write essays.

## January

- **January 18 – February 1 – Redlands Scholarship Foundation Application**
- **Complete CSS Profile (check schools for deadlines).**

## Spring

- Submit partial transcripts if requested
- Community College Application opens (SOAR)
  - Orientation meeting
  - English/Math placement test
  - Counseling/educational plan
- Submit transcript if your college requests one.
- UC Writing Placement test, if not exempt.
- Look for housing information, submit housing application and deposit.
- Admissions decisions are being mailed out.
- **March 2nd –FAFSA deadline**
- May 1st – Intent to Register deadline
- Submit deposit.
- Request your final high school transcript to be mailed.
